



PASTA E FAGIOLI

I can't tell you how much I enjoy staying with Franca and Paolo while I am in Italy. The friends I have made there while teaching and visiting have meant a lot to me and I know it is true for all of us who have made the journey to the fair Land of Italy to teach. We have always been met with open arms. ~ Shara

Ingredients:

- 1 big can of boiled beans natural, no flavor, about 6 cups.
- 5 Tablespoons tomato puree (natural, no flavor)
- 2 Tablespoons Olive Oil
- 5 Sage Leaves
- 2 Sprigs of Rosemary
- 1 Bay Leaf
- 2 or 3 Fresh Garlic Cloves
- Salt & Pepper to taste
- Pasta
- Water

Directions:

1. Heat the oil in a medium height pan.
2. Add garlic - when brown remove it from pan.
3. Add tomato puree and herbs and cook for a few minutes.
4. Meanwhile, take a portion of beans about 1/3 (2 cup) and puree.
5. Add the whole beans and the puree to the tomatoes, add the water needed to cook the pasta, salt and ground pepper.
6. Serves 4. Enjoy!
